Day 3 was the actual wedding day. On the morning of, I got dressed/made up at the Garden City Hotel in Garden City, NY. The hotel was about 10 minutes from the wedding venue, Floral Terrace in Floral Park, NY. My family arrived there after getting ready and waited for the groom and his family and friends to arrive. Guests arrived and signed a guestbook which I ordered from A.I.FRIEDMAN and took small polaroids for the book as they walked in.
